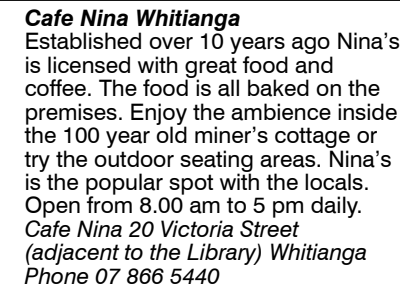

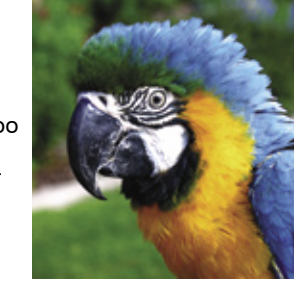

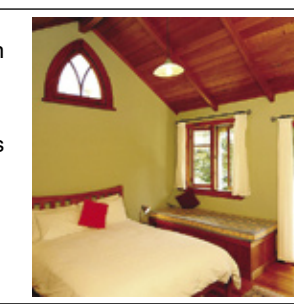
Hahei is a most spectacular and brilliantly white sandy beach with a friendly commercial centre. From the water the coastline is all white cliffs, sandy bays, caves, small islands and blowholes. Go and look with **Cathedral Cove Sea Kayaks** or the **Hahei Explorer**. A scenic one hour (each way) walk from the end of Grange Road takes you to famous **Cathedral Cove**. Reasonable fees is required. Note that there is no access to the cave from Lees Road. Part of this coast is protected as a **Marine Reserve**.
